CREDENTIALS AND PHOTO BIBS

Credentials can be picked up at the Jon M. Huntsman Center on March 7 and 8, and at identified locatations at the venues each day. At Park City Mountain Resort, the location is the media tent near the finish area. At Solider Hollow, the location is outside of the Competition Building.

Photographers are required to wear bibs at Soldier Hollow, which can be picked up at the credential distribution table. No bibs are required at Park City Mountain Resort.

MEDIA WORK AREAS

There are designated spaces in a tent near the finish area at Park City Mountain Resort and the bottom floor of the CMB building at Soldier Hollow.

POST-COMPETITION MEDIA AVAILABILITY

All coaches and student-athletes will be made available for post-competition interviews following the 10-minute cooling-off period. All interviews are to be arranged through Mike Lageschulte. Interviews will take place near or around the finish line for each competition. If weather conditions require, those interviews will take place inside the media work areas.
