

# Saint Michael's College Alpine Skiing 2022 NCAA Championship Notes



# **Head Coach Gus MacLeod '02**

Under the guidance of 12th-year head coach **Gus MacLeod '02**, the Saint Michael's College Alpine skiing program has become a regional power in the Eastern Intercollegiate Ski Association (EISA), joining the likes of Dartmouth College, Middlebury College and the University of Vermont. MacLeod was named EISA Coach of the Year for the second time in six seasons this winter - Saint Michael's actually swept the coaching honors, with Nordic head coach **Molly Peters** also landing EISA Coach of the Year.

MacLeod's men's and women's teams placed among the top four in 10 of 16 carnival events this winter, including seven of eight men's races. His skiers combined for 17 individual top-10 finishes, with four different Purple Knights combining to reach the podium

five times. Fourteen of the 22 NCAA Championship Alpine and Nordic skiing qualifiers in College history have come in MacLeod's tenure, with those 14 accounting for 23 qualifications.

One of MacLeod's charges, first-year **Sarah Escobar**, qualified for the 2022 Winter Olympic Games, becoming the first woman to represent Ecuador at a Winter Olympics. Escobar, a dual citizen of the United States and Ecuador, was the lone athlete representing the country at last month's Games, and served as flag bearer during the opening ceremony. She competed in the giant slalom, completing her opening run in 60th place, but was among 49 of the 82 starters who did not complete two runs. Escobar was accompanied at the Games by Saint Michael's assistant coach **Nick Stagers**, who has coached alongside MacLeod for 10 years.


